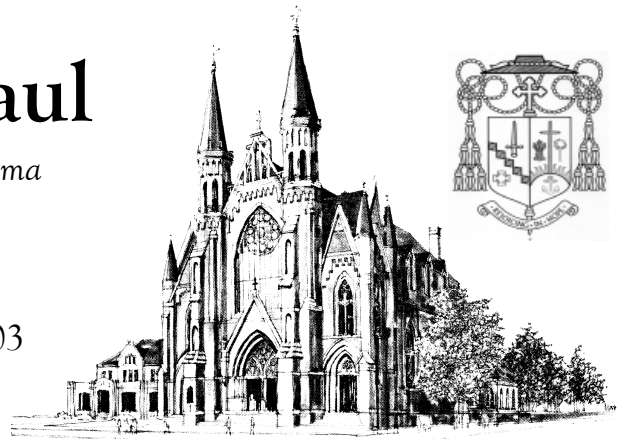

Anointing of the Sick

For those who have reached the use of reason and are in danger of death from sickness or old age. Anointing is ordinarily preceded by Confession. Contact a priest. In emergencies, call anytime.

Baptism

The Church instructs parents to seek baptism for their child within the first few weeks after birth. Contact the office, preferably during the pregnancy, to make the arrangements.

Holy Matrimony

Contact the Wedding Coordinator at least 6 months in advance. Subject to the Cathedral's wedding guidelines.

Contact the office prior to making arrangements with the funeral home. To learn about the columbarium, call the office.

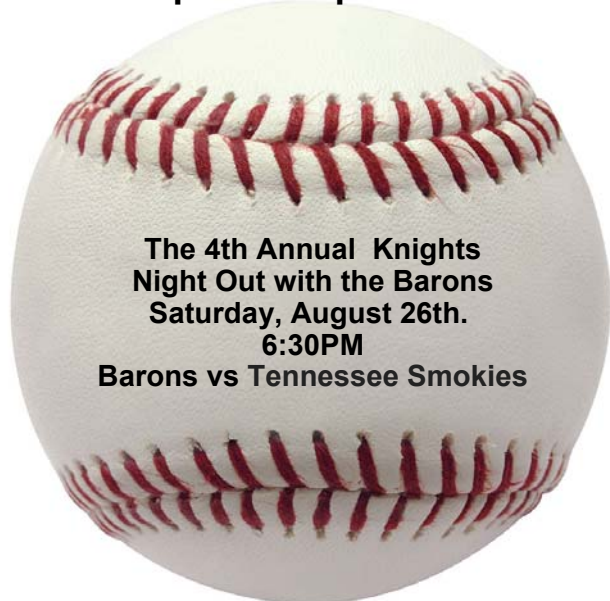

Diocesan Prayer Vigil for Refugees and Immigrants Cathedral of St. Paul

All are welcome on Friday, July 7th for Mass at 7:00pm, Adoration and Confession all night, concluding with Mass at 7:00am. The Church stands in solidarity with the needs of refugees and immigrants especially with our Hispanic brothers and sisters who make up such of large portion of this Diocese. We offer this vigil for the intention of a "Comprehensive Immigration Reform" which will open a readily obtainable path to legal status for families struggling to survive.

The meaning of this hour is that we need to renew our country in the image of her founding promises of universal rights rooted in God. Immigration is about more than immigration. This was because the colored plastic film coating on the previous set of globes was peeling off and they needed replacing. (Alas, if only it were possible to get actual colored glass globes, instead of plastic, anymore!) Father decided to go with traditional colors this time around. Blue is the traditional color for Our Lady and amber or green is what is often used for St. Joseph – we went with amber. In addition, a generous parishioner made it possible for us to purchase racks of votive lights for St. Anthony – new this week! We went with green for him. Please note the slight increase to a \$3 suggested donation for each candle (which burns for five days), so that we can cover our costs for this wonderful devotion.
