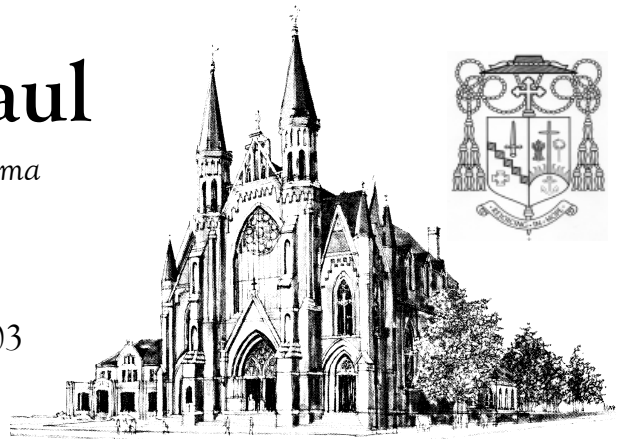

For those who have reached the use of reason and are in danger of death from sickness or old age. Anointing is ordinarily preceded by Confession. Contact a priest. In emergencies, call anytime.

Baptism

The Church instructs parents to seek baptism for their child within the first few weeks after birth. Contact the office, preferably during the pregnancy, to make the arrangements.

Holy Matrimony

Contact the Wedding Coordinator at least 6 months in advance. Subject to the Cathedral's wedding guidelines.

Catholic Vocabulary

Fair Linen

The fair linen is the long altar cloth that usually hangs down the sides almost to the floor, but sometimes a bit shorter. Often it combines with decorative elements, such as lace trims. As the name implies, this cloth is traditionally made of linen, as are all of the altar cloths. In fact, traditionally there were a total of three layers of cloth on our altars, the bottom-most layer being coated in wax and so resisting absorption of spills. The two layers above it were to help with absorption of any spill. There is no longer any legislation on the number of layers, and indeed, there are few people left with knowledge of how to apply the wax coating to the bottom cloth -- a veritable lost art. Since these cloths are used on the altar of sacrifice, however, they should always be of high quality and in good, well-kept condition.
