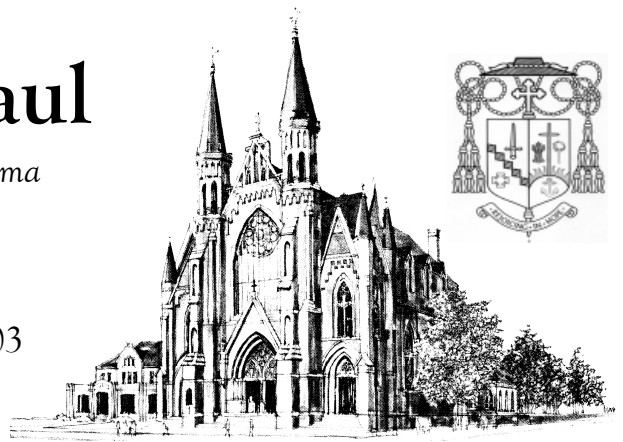

The Church instructs parents to seek baptism for their child within the first few weeks after birth. Contact the office, preferably during the pregnancy, to make the arrangements.

Holy Matrimony

Contact the Wedding Coordinator at least 6 months in advance. Subject to the Cathedral's wedding guidelines.

Contact the office prior to making arrangements with the funeral home. To learn about the columbarium, call the office.

Seminarian Christopher Green

This summer Fr. Jerabek has graciously agreed to mentor seminarian Christopher Green. Born and raised in Huntsville, Christopher is the second oldest in a family of eleven children. During his childhood his family were members of Good Shepherd parish in Huntsville, where he served as an altar boy and sang in the choir. Following a series of moves, his family became members of Our Lady Help of Christians in Huntsville, a small but growing parish dedicated to the traditional Latin Mass.

He and his siblings were home-schooled through high school, and after graduation in 2002 Christopher studied electrical engineering at the University of Alabama in Huntsville. Graduating college in 2008, Christopher continued to work in engineering until he was accepted as a seminarian by His Excellency, Bishop Baker. Christopher entered seminary in the Fall of 2014 at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, OH, where he has recently finished his third year of formation for the priesthood. Christopher has three years remaining in theological studies, with an anticipated completion in the Spring of 2020. Some of Christopher's interests are soccer, Gregorian chant, and conversational Latin. Christopher will be accompanying Fr.
