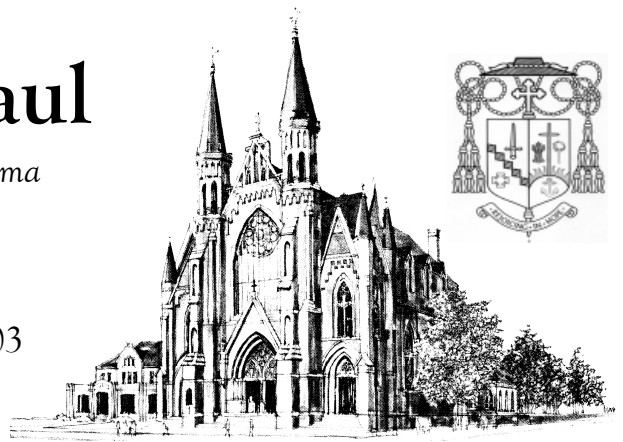

## Catholic Vocabulary

### SICK-CALL CRUCIFIX

It used to be that many Catholic couples received as a wedding gift a certain type of crucifix to hang above the marriage bed: a "sick-call crucifix". These crucifixes have a cavity inside (the top usually slides off) that contains some items that are useful when a priest comes on a "sick visit": usually a small bottle for holy water, sometimes a couple of cotton balls (with which the priest could clean the holy oil from the Anointing of the Sick off his finger), and often one or two small candles. There are often places where the candles can be inserted as well and the crucifix propped up between them so that it creates a little bedside shrine for the priest's visit. Traditionally, when a priest brought the Most Blessed Sacrament to the bedside of a sick person, a family member greeted him at the door holding a lit candle upon his arrival and then accompanied him to the sick person's room. The candle(s) stayed lit until the Blessed Sacrament had been consumed or until the priest left. This is a beautiful and traditional sign of reverence for the Holy Eucharist! (In nine years of priesthood, I've only seen this done once - we have lost a lot of our beautiful traditions!) These types of crucifixes are still sold today and it would be a wonderful thing if we returned to the tradition of gifting newlyweds with one! You can buy them from Catholic shops like the EWTN Catalogue Shoppe or the Shrine in Hanceville. And it would be also a fine idea if we instructed our children about them and taught them about their proper use - and about calling a priest when mom or dad is ill and could benefit from the sacraments! Finally, it would be good if we all made sure that we had a crucifix - whether of the "sick call" variety or a regular one - hanging above our beds!
