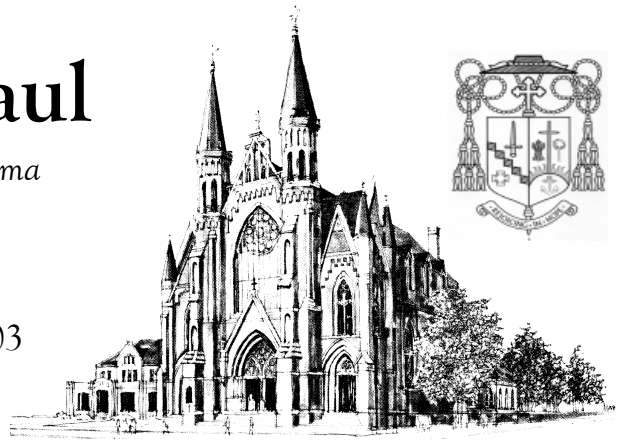

The Church instructs parents to seek baptism for their child within the first few weeks after birth. Contact the office, preferably during the pregnancy, to make the arrangements.

## Holy Matrimony

Contact the Wedding Coordinator at least 6 months in advance. Subject to the Cathedral's wedding guidelines.

### NEW MARIAN FEAST DAY

The Vatican announced last week that Pope Francis has ordered the addition of a new liturgical memorial in honor of our Blessed Mother. The memorial of Mary, Mother of the Church will be celebrated each year (starting this year) on the Monday following Pentecost. There is a long history of this Marian title, but it was especially popularized by Bl. Pope Paul VI and Pope St. John Paul II. Pope John Paul had a mosaic image of Our Lady, Mother of the Church, installed overlooking St. Peter's Square following his survival of the assassination attempt of 1981. Since this feast day only has the rank of memorial we will not alter our daily Mass schedule for it, but I wanted you to be aware of this wonderful addition to the liturgical calendar! — Father Jerabek
