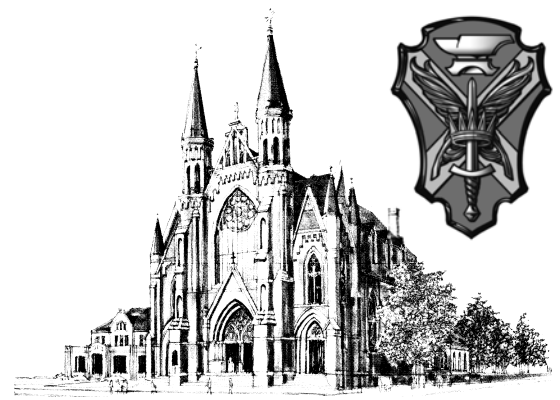

### Anointing of the Sick

For those who have reached the use of reason and are in danger of death from sickness or old age. Anointing is ordinarily preceded by Confession. Contact a priest. In emergencies, call anytime.

### Baptism

The Church instructs parents to seek baptism for their child within the first few weeks after birth. First-time parents ordinarily must attend a pre-baptismal class. Contact the office, preferably during the pregnancy, to make the arrangements.

### Holy Matrimony

Contact the Wedding Coordinator at least six (6) months in advance. Subject to the Cathedral's wedding guidelines.

### Funerals and Columbarium

Contact the office prior to making arrangements with the funeral home. To learn about the columbarium, call the office.

### Three Important Announcements

**No Masses at the Cathedral on Saturday, June 29:** There will not be a Saturday morning or evening Mass at the Cathedral on June 29. Instead, Bishop Baker has asked all parishes to encourage parishioners to come to the Vigil Mass at the Eucharistic Congress at 4 p.m. that Saturday. At the conclusion of that Mass, Missionary Disciples will be commissioned by Bishop Baker from among those who have taken part in the "Called. Formed. Sent." studies of his pastoral letter at parishes across the Diocese.

**Eucharistic Procession on Friday, June 28:** Information about the route for the Eucharistic Procession from the BJCC to the Cathedral has been posted on the Diocese's Facebook page (and on the Cathedral's Facebook page). The procession, stretching almost a mile long, will begin at the BJCC around 8 p.m. It will include several stops along the way at altars for benediction, followed by benediction on the steps of the Cathedral and all-night adoration at the Cathedral. Six shuttle buses will be available to help transport people back to the BJCC after the procession concludes at the Cathedral.

**Volunteers are Needed on Wednesday:** Volunteers are needed on June 26 to help stuff bags to be distributed to attendees at the Eucharistic Congress. With enough volunteers, this job can be completed in one day. If necessary, though, volunteers will also be needed on Thursday, June 27. Bag stuffing will take place in the CLC from 8:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday, although a few set-up helpers at 8 a.m. would be helpful. To ensure that we have enough volunteers, please email [cindy\\_durham@bellsouth.net](mailto:cindy_durham@bellsouth.net) to let us know what time you can assist. If you volunteer for Thursday, watch for a confirmation email at the end of the day Wednesday as to whether Thursday will be needed.
