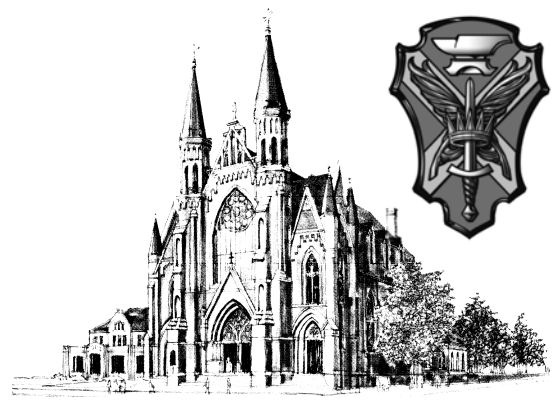

Anointing of the Sick

For those who have reached the use of reason and are in danger of death from sickness or old age. Anointing is ordinarily preceded by Confession. Contact a priest. In emergencies, call anytime.

Baptism

The Church instructs parents to seek baptism for their child within the first few weeks after birth. First-time parents ordinarily must attend a pre-baptismal class. Contact the office, preferably during the pregnancy, to make the arrangements.

Holy Matrimony

Contact the Wedding Coordinator at least six (6) months in advance. Subject to the Cathedral's wedding guidelines.

Contact the office prior to making arrangements with the funeral home. To learn about the columbarium, call the office.

Speaker Highlight: Sister Bethany Madonna, SV

On Saturday, June 29, one of our Eucharistic Congress breakout sessions at the BJCC will be given by Sister Bethany Madonna, SV. SV stands for "Sisters of Life." The community exists to "protect and enhance the sacredness of all human life." The Sisters of Life have opened homes for unwed mothers, provided retreats and support for anyone suffering in the aftermath of abortion, opened a retreat center in Connecticut, taught sessions on the Theology of the Body and NFP, and now have sisters across the country and in Canada.

Sister Bethany Madonna, who lives at the community's motherhouse in New York and whose day-to-day responsibilities include the formation of new novices, has been a main-stay on the "Catholic Conference Circuit" over the last few years. She combines a delightful sense of humility with a deadpan sense of humor. She focuses on real-life situations that demonstrate our need for God and for constant conversion in living the life of Christ.
