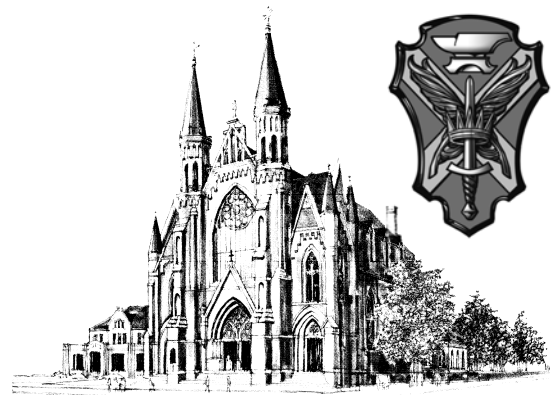

Anointing of the Sick

For those who have reached the use of reason and are in danger of death from sickness or old age. Anointing is ordinarily preceded by Confession. Contact a priest. In emergencies, call anytime.

Baptism

The Church instructs parents to seek baptism for their child within the first few weeks after birth. First-time parents ordinarily must attend a pre-baptismal class. Contact the office, preferably during the pregnancy, to make the arrangements.

Holy Matrimony

Contact the Wedding Coordinator at least six (6) months in advance. Subject to the Cathedral's wedding guidelines.

Contact the office prior to making arrangements with the funeral home. To learn about the columbarium, call the office.

—Cathedral Childrens' Schola Cantorum resumes soon! Open to all children from GR 3-8, this ensemble teaches basic music literacy (in modern and chant notation), healthy singing, and basic principles of the sung liturgy. Interested parents should contact the Director of Music to register their child and for any questions. A nominal fee is charged for participation, capped at two children per family. Cantate Domino canticum novum (your child will learn what that means!)

Permanent Diaconate Program

The Permanent Diaconate has been present in the Diocese of Birmingham in Alabama since 1973. With the arrival of Bishop Steven Raica in 2020, and at his direction, the Office of the Permanent Diaconate is looking to identify men who are interested in the Permanent Diaconate for the next formation class. Although the date for the start of the new class has not been set by Bishop Raica, the Office of the Permanent Diaconate will begin to develop a list of men who are interested in obtaining more information about the formation process. It is hoped that once the current restrictions have been relaxed, and after additional review by Bishop Raica, there will be informational sessions and an opportunity for men, and their wives, to learn more about the Permanent Diaconate and the formation process in the future.
