Notes:

- The 8:30am Mass, ordinarily celebrated by Bishop Raica, closes weekly with the seasonal Marian antiphon (e.g., *Salve Regina*, *Alma Redemptoris Mater*, etc.), and omits the closing hymn.
- Donations to the Music Fund of the Cathedral are graciously received at any time. These gifts help keep our Choral Library up to date, allow concerts and recitals to be presented, and help enrich the Sacred Liturgy with instruments and the like on special occasions. - All choral ensembles accept new members on a rolling basis. A new ensemble, the St. Cecilia Choir, helps lead congregational singing at the 8:30am Mass. Cathedral Choir leads music at the 11:00am Mass and on Holy Days. Both ensembles rehearse weekly on Wednesdays. New members must take a short, low-stress audition with the Director of Music. Cathedral Childrens' Schola Cantorum is open to children from grades 3-8 with unchanged voices. For information on all our musical offerings, please contact the Director of Music.
