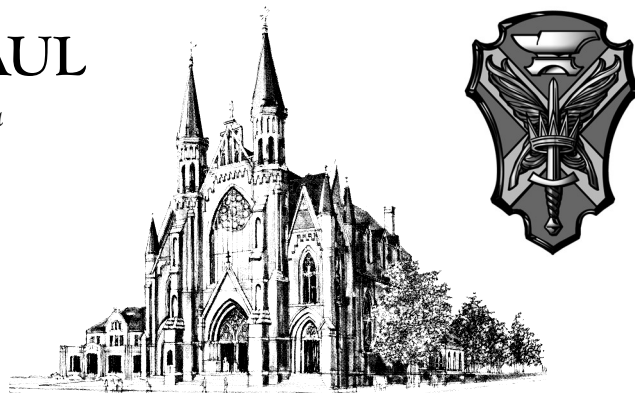

Anointing of the Sick

For those who have reached the use of reason and are in danger of death from sickness or old age. Anointing is ordinarily preceded by Confession. Contact a priest. In emergencies, call anytime and select the emergency option.

Baptism

The Church instructs parents to seek baptism for their child within the first few weeks after birth. First-time parents ordinarily must attend a pre-baptismal class. Contact the office, preferably during the pregnancy, to make the arrangements. Godparents must meet Church requirements.

Holy Matrimony

Contact the Wedding Coordinator at least six months in advance. Subject to the Cathedral's wedding guidelines (on web site) and Diocesan policies.

Funerals and Columbarium

Contact the office prior to making arrangements with the funeral home. To learn more about the columbarium including costs, call the office.

ACCESS YOUR MEMBER RECORD & GIVING STATEMENT!

Good news! We now have a way that registered Cathedral members can access their membership record (including making address changes or other corrections) and also download not only this year's giving statements but those from prior years as well. Setup requires a few easy steps:

Go to <http://birmingham.parishsoftfamilysuite.com>

1. Click "New User?"
2. Choose the Cathedral from the drop-down box and otherwise fill in the blanks and submit
3. Once we approve your registration by matching it up with your record, you'll receive an email with a temporary password. Log in with that temporary password and select your permanent password; keep this info in a safe place. Once you have your account set up, if you ever need your password reset, just contact us and we can do so. Otherwise, any changes you make (e.g. address changes) will be sent to us for review and approval! Also, while giving statements will be mailed soon, some of you are doing your taxes already and may want them sooner. The one that you can download and print is the same as the one we will mail!

LENTEN FASTING AND ABSTINENCE REGULATIONS

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory **days of fasting and abstinence** for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on **fasting** are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. Pregnant women and others for whom fasting would be perilous to their health are exempted. Those fasting are permitted to eat one full meal; two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning **abstinence** from meat are binding for all from age 14 onwards. Broths made from meat (as long as there are no pieces of meat in it) are permissible according to the letter of the law, though perhaps not fully coherent with its spirit. Vegetarians do well on days of abstinence to give up a certain food or dish that they regularly enjoy, since they already give up meat, not for penitential reasons, but as a way of life.

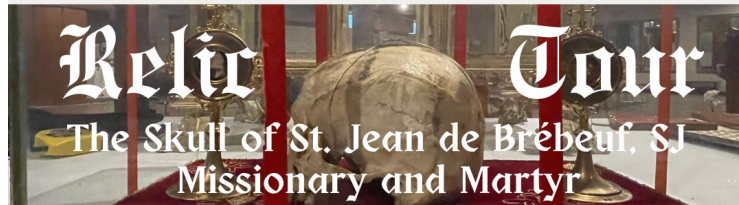
