

Send forth Your light and Your truth; these have led me and brought me to Your holy mountain and to Your dwelling place.




## THE LITURGY OF THE WORD






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## OFFERTORY ANTIPHON (11:00AM) Confitebor tibi

PSALM 118:7, 10, 17, 25



## HOLY COMMUNION


We invite all Catholics who are properly disposed (i.e., in the state of grace and having fasted for one hour before communion) to come forward in the usual way to receive Holy Communion.


